The Office of Education Quality and Accountability have recently distributed a school report card for each public school in the state of Oklahoma. These report cards outline information based upon data from the 2015-16 school year.

As you review this information, I hope that you are pleased with the results. Our scores on the End of Instruction Tests in English II, U. S. History, Biology I, Algebra II, Geometry and English III all exceed the state average. As you may know, the 2015-2016 school year was the last year that the state utilized that specific EOI testing model, and the state is now adopting new testing measures for years subsequent to the 2015-2016 school year. While we are proud of these scores, we continue to strive to enhance student learning experiences so that ALL students will have the opportunity to be successful.

An academic performance indicator not listed in this report for 2015-16 is that JHS students earned passing scores on 1,043 Advanced Placement (AP) tests. Members of the Senior Class of 2016 had an ACT composite average of 23.4, and seniors were offered college scholarships exceeding 22.5 million dollars.

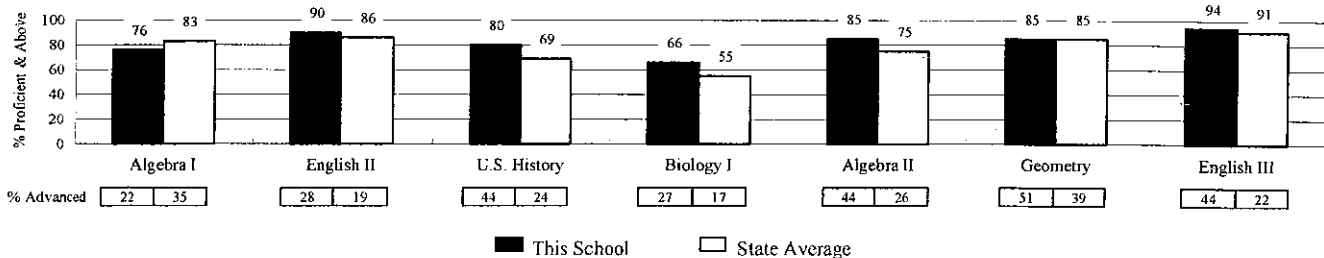
